

LOCAL LAW NO. 18 OF 2016

**A LOCAL LAW ENTITLED
PUBLIC DRINKING**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE
OF SHOREHAM, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this local law is to regulate the
consumption of alcoholic beverages in public places in the
Village.

SECTION 2. ENACTMENT.

A Chapter 21 of the Village Code entitled Public
Drinking is enacted, as follows:

§ 21-1. Legislative Intent.

The purpose of this Chapter 21, entitled a Public Drinking
Law, is to regulate the consumption of alcoholic beverages in
public places in the Village.

§ 21-2. Regulation of Public Drinking.

No person shall consume any alcoholic beverage as defined
in The Alcoholic Beverage Control Law, or have in possession an
open container having any amount of such beverage, in any public
place in the Village, except as otherwise approved by the
Village Board:

§ 21-3. Penalties.

A. Schedule of Fines. Any person in violation of this
Chapter 21 shall be subject to a minimum fine of fifty (50)
dollars but not to exceed one hundred (100) dollars for the
first offense, a minimum fine of two hundred (200) dollars but
not to exceed four hundred (400) dollars for a second offense.

B. Schedule of Additional Fines. All fines on all penalties authorized in this Chapter 21 shall increase, as follows:

(1) At thirty (30) days from issuance, minimum fine shall be doubled.

(2) At sixty (60) days from issuance, minimum fine shall be tripled from original amount.

§ 21-4. Severability.

If any provision of this Chapter 21 is ruled unconstitutional or invalid, said ruling shall not affect the validity of other provisions of said chapter or said chapter as a whole.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.

SECTION 4. REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING LOCAL LAWS.

This local law upon its effective date shall in all respects repeal and supersede § 78-2 of the 1967 and 1989 Village Ordinances.
