Board Items

(Meetings of January 9, February 13, and March 13, 2007)

Recreation The Village has received a report from Reilly Platform Tennis regarding needed repairs and resurfacing of the courts, last done seven years ago. The Board approved \$8,500 for the repairs, citing the need to maintain Village facilities.

Design Review Board Hearing After discussions stretching over several months and the advice of counsel, the Board has tentatively approved the establishment of a Design Review Board to replace the existing Architectural Review Board. The replacement Law will describe the function and duties of the Design Review Board consistent with legal strictures and practices and clarify ambiguities in the existing Law. Residents may review the proposed Law at the Village Hall and may comment on it at the hearing on April 10, 2007 at 7:30 PM at the Village Hall.

Plantings The Board approved contracts with two vendors for plantings and maintenance at various venues within the Village.

Dogs A number of residents have reported vicious dog attacks on their pets while walking them on the road in the Ashley Lane area. These residents have made official reports to Town of Brookhaven Animal Control in accordance with Village regulations. Mayor Klatsky will follow up on this problem with Town Supervisor Foley.

Beach The Board approved Commissioner Weiss' request for \$800 to replace the tube portion of the Village raft/trampoline.

Acoustics At the request of Village Hall Commissioner Scrimenti, the Board approved an allocation of \$8,500 for the hiring of a certified

acoustical engineering firm, which will prepare a plan for improving the acoustics at the Village Hall. A sub-committee of residents has met with the engineer several times and will do so again before a final commitment is made.

Village Hall Rentals The Board approved Village Hall rentals for February 4, March 2, March 3, March 10, March 16, March 24, April 7, April 21, April 27, April 28, May 27, June 22, June 30, July 1, July 7, July 21, July 22, August 4, August 12, August 23, August 24, August 25, September 1, September 8, September 15, October 20, October 28, November 4, December 15, and December 16, 2007 and June 28, 2008. Also approved were Village Movie Nights on March 30, April 30, June 15, July 18, and August 15, 2007.

Dogs Residents are reminded that Village law prohibits owning, keeping, harboring or maintaining any vicious dog within the Village. A dog is considered a "vicious dog" if it has attacked any person or pet two or more times within an eighteen month period in a place where they may lawfully be located or passing. Dogs are not permitted to run "at large" in the Village of Shoreham.

Meeting with School Superintendent The Village Board will host a meeting with School Superintendent Harriet Coppel at 7 PM on Wednesday, April 25 at the Village Hall. This informal gathering will give Village residents an opportunity to ask questions or discuss concerns with Dr. Coppel. The meeting last year was very well attended.
