

## Board Items

(Meeting of June 10, 2014)

**Budget** After a public hearing the Board adopted a revised budget for 2014-2015. There will be an increase in the tax rate from \$409 to \$415 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation this year which includes the additional funding needed for snow removal costs by the Town of Brookhaven. For the first time in several years the bids for garbage collection require an increase in the refuse charge. The new charge will be \$344.64.

**Election** The Sound Party candidates were successful in the Village election. They are Mayor Edward Weiss and Trustees Rosie Connell and Kathleen Baumann Schnoor. Trustees Len Emma and Brian Vail have one year remaining in their term of office.

**Public Hearings on July 8<sup>th</sup>** Actions taken at the June Board meeting set July 8<sup>th</sup> as the hearing date for the following Village Laws: Steep Slopes, SEQRA (State Environmental Quality Review), an amendment to the Design Review Board Law, and continuance of the moratorium on subdivisions.

**Roads** Work on the Beach access road is continuing. The Village is awaiting the return of bids for curb work on Village roads. Once bids are received, they are in effect for the period of time for which they are contracted. Road work is not done without this bidding process

**Beach.** Additional beach storage spaces will be added if possible.

**Village Hall** Annual maintenance is underway including changing some ceiling tiles and increasing shelving in the storage area in the lower level. The Snack Shack will have curtailed hours and be evaluated after the first month of operation. Prices may increase so that money is not lost on the operation, as it has been in the past.
