## **Board Items**

(Meetings of April 10, and May 8, 2007)

**Budget Preparations** The Board reviewed the draft budget for the budget year August 1, 2007 to July 31, 2008 as presented by Treasurer Bates. The budget highlights are: 1) No change will be made to the tax rate, which will remain at \$330 per \$1000 of assessed valuation.

2) The refuse rate will be increased by \$10 per household to \$350 this new budget year.

3) Revenues and expenses are expected to increase \$19,000 or approximately 3%.

4) Total Village budget will be \$668,000.

The Board tentatively approved the draft budget and scheduled a hearing for Tuesday, June 12, 2007 to present the budget to residents. Changes may be made at this hearing.

In addition, Treasurer Bates recommended some changes in the collateralization and CD policies of the Village as proposed by the bank. These changes should be financially beneficial to the Village and the Board approved the implementation.

**Design Review Board Hearings** Village Attorney Hamberger outlined the provisions of the proposed Local Law establishing the Design Review Board and he and resident Ed Weiss answered questions posed by residents attending the April hearing. Final approval was postponed until the May meeting so that all of the Trustees could be present. After additional questions from residents the Law was approved at the May meeting subject to the attorney approving an increase in the number of alternates on the new board.

**Mandated Training** The Board approved a resolution mandating training for all members of the Zoning and Planning Boards as required by New York State.

**Roads** Bids have been received for drainage work and the bid was awarded to D.F. Stone. Additional bids will be let for curbing and road work. Engineer Falasco will be asked to look into the flooding that occurred on Upham Down during recent heavy rains.

**Village Hall Rentals** The Board approved Village Hall rentals for July 6, 2007 and August 8, 2008 as well as Village-wide Open Houses on Wednesday and Friday evenings and Sunday mornings during the warmer months. (See Notices)

**Beach Stickers** Residents needing beach and tennis parking stickers and gate transmitters should visit the Village Hall during normal Village office hours.
