## **Board Items**

(Meetings of July 9, July 30, August 13, September 10, and October 8, 2013)

**Centennial Thank You** The Mayor and the Board of Trustees formally thanked the Village Centennial Committee, stating: “Your collective efforts truly made our Centennial Year something very ‘special’. The diversity and the number of the activities you sponsored reflected the nature of Shoreham Village. You captured the essence of our ‘Sweetest Little Village’. **Flag** Mr. & Mrs. John Bates presented an American flag to the Village that had been flown over a hospital in Afghanistan where their son Dr. James Bates is the commanding officer. The flag was raised and dedicated to the Village of Shoreham on July 4, 2013.

**Generator and Benches** The Board approved a resolution to apply for a generator for the Village Hall from funding available for Village Justice Courts. Resident Steve Rogers was thanked for constructing a beautiful court bench using funding provided by NY State.

**Public Works** The Board discussed the use of the Village beach access road by both Village residents and neighboring communities. It was agreed that a bond should be posted assuring repair of any damage to Village infrastructure. Chairman Kogel continues to interact with the water company and is in the planning process for additional drain and road work.

**Building Department** The Board approved new fees for various actions requiring a building permit. This was necessitated by the requirement that State licensed inspectors be used at various times in the building process.

**Insurance** The Board approved accepting the NYMIR proposal for Village insurance.

**Village Hall Rentals** The Board approved rentals for September 21, September 22, September 23, September 28, October 26, and November 24, 2013 and June 22, 2014.

**Building Operations** The Board approved a reduction in the blackout dates for rentals in late spring and early fall, however Village events (i.e. coffee, etc.) will not be affected. Additional work will be done to improve the Village website and the rental policies and documents will be revised as needed.

Boy Scout Kyle Seda has completed and placed four benches he made around the Village Hall. The Board thanked him for his generosity.

**Beach** Engineer Falasco and Chairman J. Weiss are continuing negotiations on the repairs and rebuilding of the beach ramp and stairs. Several stabilizing boulders will be added to buttress a part of the stairs.
