

Board Items

(Meetings of December 11 and December 14, 2010 and January 5, January 11, February 8, February 19, and March 8, 2011)

Mayor Wilbur Klatsky 1932-2011

Residents and friends of the Village of Shoreham mourn the unexpected death of their Mayor and friend Wilbur Klatsky. Bill served the Village as Trustee and Mayor for over 20 years. He will be greatly missed.

Roads The Board approved the renewal of a contract with the Brookhaven Town Highway Department for general highway maintenance and repairs. A contract with S & S Landscaping will be continued for the removal of snow at the Village Hall including sanding and/or salting as needed.

Commissioner Kogel and Engineer Falasco will be compiling a list of work needed on Village roads. Temporary repairs will be made until Spring permits more permanent work.

Buildings and Grounds Commissioner Blum will pick up a fire-proof storage cabinet for gas and fuel. He also reported on the cost of installing additional lighting in the upper parking lot. Two poles will be installed at this time. The Board gave him permission to clean up the rear of the lower level parking lot.

Commissioner Blum will be surveying all Village properties to ascertain which structures may be in need of maintenance, repair or replacement in the near future. Items mentioned included the Village Hall roof and the steps to the beach.

Recreation Commissioner A. Pijacki reported electrical problems at the paddle tennis courts. Electricians are working to rectify the situation.

E-Mail Trustee Falco is working with Village Attorney Tohill to formulate a resolution which

protects resident's privacy as much as is legally possible. The Board passed this resolution. It may be read on the Village Website.

Code Enforcement The Village security vehicle is no longer able to be repaired at reasonable cost. Bids will be sent out for a replacement vehicle.

Road Signs The sign at Ashley and Woodville has been replaced. Commissioner Blum will survey all existing Village road signs to determine their condition.

Parks The Board approved projects proposed by Commissioner Mahoney for cleanup work along Woodville Road and near the gazebo.

Village Hall Commissioner Scrimenti requested and the Board approved the addition of Tommiann Naso to the Village Hall Aesthetics Committee. He also discussed the temporary removal of the railing in the bar area to improve traffic flow. Resident response has been generally favorable, but will be re-evaluated later.

Commissioners Kogel and Scrimenti have conducted an energy assessment of the heated air escaping from the Village Hall attic, soffits and other areas, resulting in large heating expenses. They will be preparing a proposal for insulating work

13, September 11, October 22, 2011. Use of the lower level for CPR training for Village lifeguards was also approved at a date to be determined as well as several Friday Night Open Houses for the entire Village with no food or beverages provided.

Trustee Weiss has been looking at financial data concerning rentals at the Village Hall. Once his report has been reviewed, it is expected that revised policies will be put in place.

Roadway Cleanup Because of excessive snow this winter, residents who were informed of their need to better maintain their roadway have been given a grace period. The Village Landscaper will be asked to begin roadside trimming after April 15th, beginning with the most egregious intrusions.
