Board Items

(Meetings of December 11, 2007 and January 8, 2008)

Tennis Courts Test boreholes have been made on the tennis courts to determine the reason for the poor drainage that occurs after heavy rains. Commissioner Pijacki will be meeting with Gold Coast Tennis to receive their recommendations.

Village Hall Rate Review The rate review committee headed by Trustee Pijacki is looking into the decline in rentals of the Village Hall. No rate changes are to be made at this time. A dedicated phone line for rentals will be considered.

Village Hall Commissioner Scrimenti reported that the locks on the Village Hall will be changed in the near future after the appropriate persons have received new keys. The purchase of new upper level chairs will be investigated as the existing chairs are breaking at an alarming rate. Several sample chairs were examined by those in attendance at the January meeting.

Roads Several residents who have placed large rocks adjacent to Village roadways will be asked to move the rocks off the right of way. As a point of information, all are reminded that each Village roadway has a right of way 8 to 15 feet on each side of the paved area.

Village Welcome Booklet The Shoreham Village Association is revising the outdated welcome booklet and will resume greeting new residents of the Village.

SEQRA Hearing At the next Village meeting on February 12, a SEQRA hearing will be held to assess the environmental impact of a resident's request to repair an upper bulkhead.

Parks Work is underway to clear invasive vines, mainly English ivy and wisteria, from the parklands. These vines are killing trees and the natural woodland undergrowth. Please call Parks Commissioners Morris or Willen if you wish to assist in this effort or to receive a copy of the procedure being used. A group led by Karen Blumer is planning to pull and dig the vines by hand in a test area to see if this approach, to be concluded by April, could avoid the use of herbicide. Please call Karen (821-0975) if you would like to assist in this trial effort.

Village Hall Rentals The Board approved Village Hall rentals for December 12, December 31, 2007, and January 25, February 10, February 29, March 15, March 28, May 2, May 11, May 25, June 7, June 14, July 5, July 26, August 9, August 17, August 23, August 30, September 13, October 11, October 25, November 29 and December 13, 2008.

Storm Water Management All residents have the responsibility of keeping their curb free of leaves and other debris. Residents without curbs should also be sure to remove leaves from the roadways adjacent to their property. The new Village Storm Water Law provides for fines if the Village must hire persons to remove leaves from roadways or trim back excessive growth.
