## Board Items

(Meeting of June 9, 2009)

**Budget** The Board adopted the proposed budget for 2009-2010. There will be an increase in the tax rate to \$350 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation this year. There will be an increase of \$12 in the refuse charge to \$381. Projected income and expenses will increase by \$16,575. The total Village budget will be \$683,475.

**Election** Incumbent trustees Pijacki and Weiss were reelected to office.

**Village Hall Rentals** The Board approved Village Hall rentals for June 5 and June 6, 2010. Also approved were Cigar Nights on the deck, coffee nights on Wednesdays and Fridays and Sunday coffee. (See dates under Notices.)
