Board Items

(Meetings of February 9, March 9, April 12, and May 11, 2010)

Budget Preparations The Board reviewed the draft budget for the budget year August 1, 2010 to July 31, 2011. The budget highlights are:

1) No change will be made in the tax rate, which will remain at \$350 per \$1000 of assessed valuation.

2) The refuse rate will increase by \$16 per household to \$397 this new budget year. This will be adjusted if June bids are lower than anticipated.

3) Expenses are expected to decrease by \$3848. Revenues are expected to decrease by \$3222 as income from mortgage fees and rentals has decreased. Revenue available from the paid-off bond on the Village Hall will be used to pay increased costs for the Village Hall maintenance, security, insurance and landscaping.

4) Total Village budget will be \$680,253. The Board considered the draft budget and scheduled a hearing for Tuesday, June 8, 2010 to present the budget to residents. Changes may be made at this hearing.

Village Elections The annual elections of the Incorporated Village of Shoreham will be held in the Village Hall from noon until 9 PM on Tuesday, June 15, 2010.

Trustees Roger Pijacki and Edward Weiss have one year remaining on their terms.

Village Attorney Anthony Tohill has been appointed Village Attorney, replacing Richard Hamburger.

Beach Commissioner J. Weiss reported that two anchors had been lost during winter storms. The Board approved their replacement. Permission was also given for use of the old raft during installation, followed by its demolition.

Village Hall Commissioner Scrimenti reported on the needed repairs to the deck. The Board approved repairs to the deck and the railing. Also approved were remodeling of the ladies room and the replacement of the entry cement walkway.

Village Historian Peter Spier has retired from his position as Village Historian, which he held for the last 25 years. The Board thanked Peter for his many years of dedicated service. Mimi Oberdorf-Falco was appointed Village Historian.

Roads Commissioner Kogel reported that he will soon meet with Deputy Town Roads Commissioner Baldassare regarding shared drainage problems. After this meeting, this year's roads/drainage projects will be decided.

Earth Day The Board commended the Shoreham Village Association and the Shoreham Garden Club on the successful Earth Day activities.

Village Hall Rentals The Board approved Village Hall rentals for March 20, March 21, April 18, July 17, July 23, August 24, August 25, August 28, September 11, and September 12, 2010. The Kilroy family was approved for a May 22, 2010 memorial service. The Boy Scouts use of the beach was approved for June 11, 2010. The Village Charity Yard sale was approved for the upper parking lot on October 17, 2010.

Notices

Beach Stickers Residents needing beach and tennis parking stickers and gate transmitters should visit the Village Hall during normal Village office hours. Bring proof of residency and auto registration. Stickers and clickers are required for parking in the Village lot. Guests passes must be shown for cars without stickers.

Property Maintenance Keep roadsides cleared of overgrown vegetation for at least 3 to 5 feet from the road's edge. Poison ivy is prohibited in the Village.
