

## Board Items

(Meetings of July 12, August 9, and September 13, 2011)

**Hurricane Irene Clean-up** Mayor Pijacki worked tirelessly with Brookhaven Town Supervisor Lesko and Legislator Bonner (both of whom visited the Village) to expedite restoration of power to the Village. He praised the work of S & S Landscaping and Koch Tree Services for their efficient work in restoring Village roadways and creating a safe environment. Participation in multiple conference calls established that the Village should be able to recover some of the clean-up costs from FEMA, provided that proper documentation is provided. Treasurer Donohue-Spier and Mayor Pijacki are coordinating this effort. S & S was asked to pick up hurricane related debris at the roadsides of property owners.

In a future emergency, a Village official will be available at the Village Hall at 6 pm to answer questions.

**Roads** Commissioner Kogel is waiting to hear from the Water Authority on their plans for major work on the water mains in the Village. Some Village drainage and repaving plans will be revised as more information is received. A work session was planned for 7:30 pm on September 27<sup>th</sup> to prioritize roadwork and to complete necessary FEMA/hurricane business.

**Village Hall** The Board approved the use of \$30,000 from capital funds for the insulation of the Village Hall attic space. Some replacement of damaged fascia and painting is expected to begin soon. A network extender has been installed at the Village Hall. It is hoped that this will improve cell phone service in the immediate area.

**Buildings & Grounds** Commissioner Blum will obtain bids for restriping the Village parking lot, including two handicapped spaces. He will include striping the parking area at Major Hopkins Park. Five missing street signs will be ordered. New fencing across the upper parking lot and replacement of split rail fencing will be explored.

**Recreation** Commissioner A. Pijacki commented on the need to replace the umbrellas at the tennis courts. It was noted that beach umbrellas also need replacing. Commissioner Blum will work with her on their replacements. The right field foul pole at the Abata ball field also needs replacing.
