

GUIDELINES FOR USE OF
SHOREHAM VILLAGE BASKETBALL COURT
February 9, 2016

Permitted Uses: Basketball, ice skating (and hockey), in-line skating (and hockey) and pickleball

Permitted Hours of Use: 9AM — 9PM

Permitted Seasons: Basketball All year
Ice Skating Per Mother Nature
In-line Skating About November 1 through about March 31

Organized Use: As permitted by the Village Board

Ice and In-Line Skating Requirements:

- (1) On or about November 1 or each year, volunteers will install boards on the perimeter of the basketball court, arched in each corner; the boards will be about 42” high (with no net above, except that protective nets shall be installed at the north and south ends of the court); goals will be installed on the north and south ends of the court such that the faces thereof shall be in line with the perimeter of the court, so as to establish the opportunity for the court to be used as a basketball court and rollerblading rink. Two gates will be part of the installation (probably on the west side of the rink).
- (2) On or about April 1, volunteers will dismantle the above and store same off-site.
- (3) Rollerblades will have wide, soft rollers to minimize damage to the court. Such damage (and any damage from hockey sticks) will likely only entail scuff marks. Any such damage will be repaired at the end of the season. General maintenance of the boards and goals will also be effected during and after the season.
- (4) Anyone playing hockey shall be required to wear appropriate protective gear, including a helmet.

Confinement of Use: The permitted uses above shall be confined to the basketball court, with the understanding that the tennis courts (both hard and soft)

and platform tennis courts shall not be permitted to be used for in-line, or any other type of, skating, cycling, the playing of hockey, whether on skates or in sneakers or other footwear, or any other activity other than the playing of tennis or platform tennis, as the case may be.

Cost to Village:

The above will be provided without charge to the Village.

Trial Period:

If all goes well during the first year of the program, we'll continue same into the future.
