TENNIS ROUND-UP

Last weekend, Shoreham tennis moved a step closer to its Labor Day climax. Aided by perfect weather, the survivors in the men's and women's tournaments battled in the semi-finals to decide who would meet in the finals, Saturday, September 3, for the coveted trophies.

In a delayed quarter-final round, Herb Tastrom took the first set 6-3 in his match with Paul Vermylen, before bowing 6-3, 6-2 in the second and third sets. In a semi-final round match, John Bates was the winner over Tom Adams 6-2, 6-1. The score was no indication of the closeness of the play. Both men produced sparkling shots that drew repeated applause from the gallery. Although the outcome was never really in doubt, it was good tennis all the way. In the other semi-final match, mixing a chop game with repeated forays to the net and never losing his accurate control of shots, Jim McCrystal disposed of Paul Vermylen, 6-2, 6-3. Bates and McCrystal, therefore, will meet for the championship this Saturday.

Two excellent semi-final matches marked the ladies' play. Like a true champion, Mary Jane Stangby, last year's tournament winner, rallied after losing the first set to defeat Dee McCrystal 2-6, 6-2, 6-4. Dee was a constant threat, and the increasing severity of her play this season marks her for possible upset victories in tournaments to come. The other semi-final match saw Ann Hapgood triumph over Jean Johnson 6-1, 7-5. In the final set Jean held set point repeatedly, leading by as much as 5-2. Ann, however, fought her way back, playing some of her best tennis, to win five games in a row and the match.

The weekend in Shoreham reaches its high point with finals in the men's, ladies', and boys' singles scheduled for Saturday and the annual team match with Wading River. Win or lose, the matches with Wading River always produce some of the best tennis of the season, so come early and get a good seat!
