



ACTIVITIES SURVEY

Under each name and along side each activity desired, list the type of program desired. If more than one level of activity is appropriate, please note. i.e. If a "Youth Counsellor" program plus "Individual Professional Instructions" are desired in "Water Skiing," list numbers 2 and 4 along side "Water Skiing" under the name of the person concerned.

Program types:

1. Informal. Little or no organized program.
2. Youth Counsellor. General program of play and instructions under the supervision of college student personnel.
3. Group Instruction by a teaching professional.
4. Private Instruction by a teaching professional.

Instructions by professionals, here or at nearby facilities, may be provided as a supplement to and/or in lieu of the general youth counsellor program. Private or group instructions would be on a subscription basis under the auspices of the Shoreham Country Club. Examples of prevailing rates are as follows for "pro" lessons:

- Tennis: \$10.00/hr., private.
 \$2.00/hr. in groups of six.
Horseback riding: \$3.00/hr., private.
Golf: \$7.50/hr., private.
Sailing: \$1.00/hr. per person in groups of 20 or more.
Painting: 75¢/hr. per person in groups of 10 or more.





SOMEONE IS RESPONSIBLE!

Yes, someone is responsible for a blight that plagues Shoreham this year, perhaps more than ever before - broken glass. You can see it on our beach, along our roads, in our play areas - wherever barefoot children are liable to wander. This week one child was cut severely, but the glass continues to fall.

Who is responsible? Is it the tiny child, too young to realize the lethal character of broken glass? Is it the child in his teens, old enough to know that the glass he breaks can maim a small foot for life - but so insistent on undisciplined freedom that he feels he doesn't have to care? Or is it the parent who hasn't bothered to consider that his child may be one of the prime offenders?

We will probably never know the answer. But if anyone doubts how malicious the glass breaking has become, then note this one incident. . . . As you know our tiny children like to run, jump, and play in the tide pool area of the beach. On a night early this week a beer party was held in this area. Part of the festivities included glass breaking. A cinder block was set up on a log in the middle of the tide pool area. Approximately two dozen bottles were shattered against it. Where the day before our small children played in safety, now there lay in wait under eight or ten inches of water, hundreds of pieces of glass. There is no effective way of cleaning up this area - there is no effective way of keeping our little children away from their favorite play area . . .
