AN OPEN LETTER TO TEENAGERS

Anywhere, U.S.A.

Dear Sons and Daughters,

There is something in the air that pushes older people into making speeches to teenagers. Perhaps it's the newspaper pictures of those nice-looking high school graduates or the accounts of the Commencement addresses orated by various dignitaries, usually windy and full of platitudes. Whatever the reason, here is our speech to you.

The things that count in life are really very simple. Examples: the feeling of excitement and accomplishment that comes from doing work well — any work; the ability to be tolerant in trying to see the other fellow's point of view, and respecting his rights.

We oldsters (everybody over 25) complain about your failure to persevere. We nag at you. We shake our heads over juvenile delinquency. We criticize your crazes. We are very apt to reminisce about how things were different and better in our time. But, underneath, most of us believe today's crop of young people are pretty swell, certainly smarter, and probably more responsible than earlier generations. We just don't take time to say all the good things. We are afraid of spoiling you.

Please remember, now and then, that there is no case on record of a parent who was not once a teenager. It seems improbable to you that your parents were ever young, but they really were. Much of the rebellion has worn off, as it will wear off with you. Even so, parents do understand what's on your mind. This leads to the suggestion that you believe at least half of what we tell you — but do believe that!

SAILING RACE RESULTS


